EDUCATION IS A JOURNEY, NOT A DESTINATION.

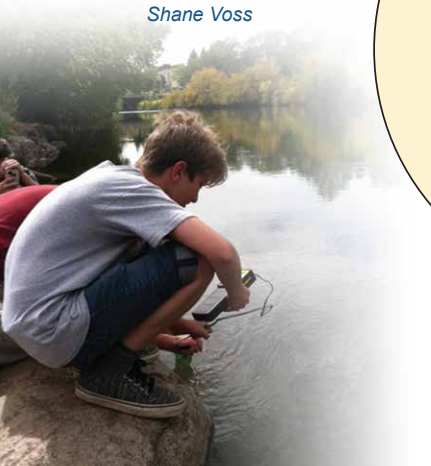

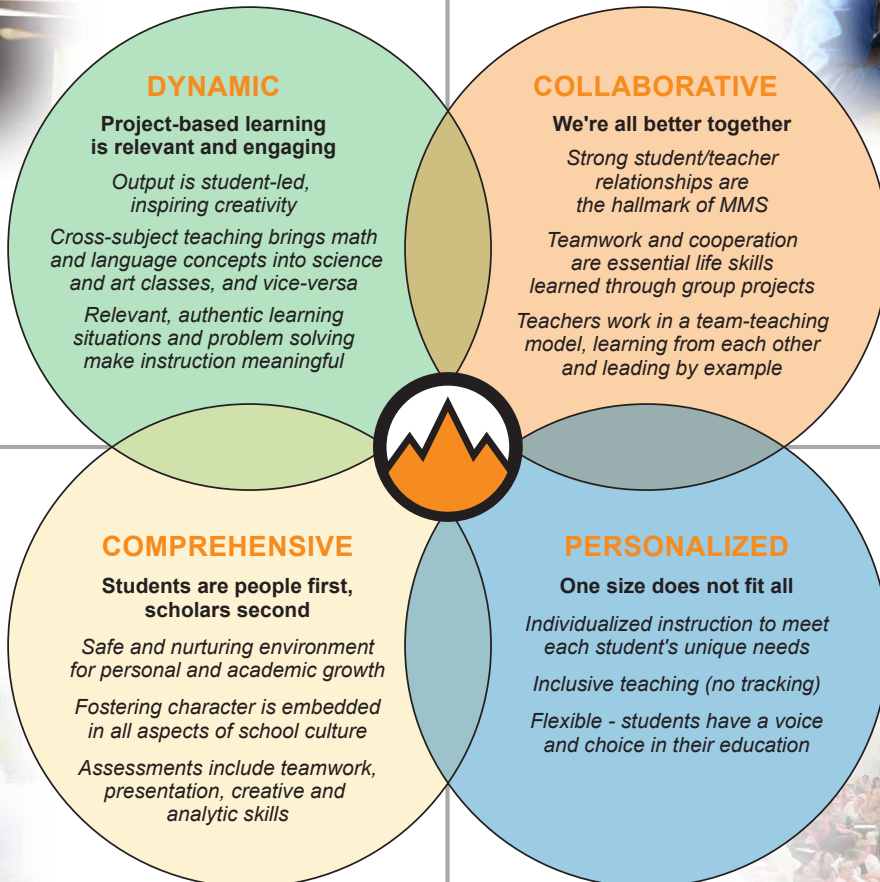
